### Smart Thermostat

#### Eligibility:

- Limited to ENERGY STAR certified smart thermostats
- Limited to one smart thermostat rebate per household
- Rebate paid will not exceed the smart thermostat purchase price, excluding taxes, shipping and installation charges
- Available for a new smart thermostat installed in an existing home or a new addition

## Central Air Conditioner and Air Source Heat Pump Tune-Ups

#### Eligibility:

- One discount per household per calendar year
- Existing equipment must be three years of age or older. Equipment is only eligible for a tuneup once every three years
- Discount may be applied on the first tune-up of a new pre-paid maintenance agreement, but may not be applied to an existing pre-paid maintenance agreement

# Duct Sealing

#### Eligibility:

- Duct sealing will need to be performed by a Service Provider to ensure that the system is running within manufacturer specifications
- New construction is not eligible

# Home Heating and Cooling Products and Specifications

Customers in the following towns served by municipal electric authorities may not be eligible as they do not pay into the ComEd fund. Customer eligibility will be verified.

#### Additional Program Requirements

Installed equipment, such as a smart thermostat, cannot have been incentivized or discounted by any other ComEd program. Transactions must be submitted within 60 days of installation. Installing contractor must include the ComEd discount as a line item on the customer's invoice and inform all participants that ComEd and third party evaluators will do QA/QCs throughout the year and may reach out to residential customers for additional verification.
