2017 DTE Project of the Month

MDOT & HNTB Corp.

In 2016, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) installed new LED lighting on a number of major Metro Detroit freeways.


MDOT completed 16 projects with assistance from its contractor, HNTB Corp., and received \$1 million in DTE Energy incentives.

Nearly 13,000 new LED fixtures were installed, replacing various outdated high pressure sodium, metal halide and mercury vapor fixtures.

MDOT expects the project to improve the current lighting infrastructure, enhance safety and achieve energy savings through the use of new technologies.

As a result of the upgrades, MDOT will save an estimated 14,275,000 in annual kWh consumption, 171,300,000 kWh in lifetime savings and \$1.3 million in annual energy costs.
