The DTE Energy Efficiency Program for Business is offering a special incentive bonus for chains or franchises with multiple locations doing projects under the same tax ID or parent company. We hope that this offer will encourage wide spread adoption of energy efficient measures that apply to several locations. This offer took effect on May 1, and runs through October 30, 2019 and will only apply to electric incentives.

This bonus is based on a tier structure, with a higher incentive bonus being paid to more participating locations with the same tax ID or parent company. The tiered bonus structure is as follows:

Paid locations 2-10 will receive a 30% bonus Paid locations 11-20 will receive a 40% bonus Paid locations 21+ will receive a 50% bonus

Trade ally Q&A

Q: The rebate application process for lighting can be somewhat confusing, and it would be helpful if there were some examples provided for how to classify various types of lighting measures.

A: The DTE Energy Efficiency Program for Business Program references lighting upgrades in four categories: interior under 15 ft. (ceiling height), interior over 15 ft. (ceiling height), interior and exterior 24/7 operation, and exterior. Chiller tune-up bonus

The DTE Energy Efficiency Program for Business is offering a special chiller tune-up bonus; customers and contractors may qualify for additional money.

DTE customers who have tune-ups performed on chillers will receive their regular \$5.00 incentive per ton, plus an additional \$2.50 bonus per ton. In addition, the contractor performing the tune-ups will also receive a \$2.50 bonus per ton.

The contractor will be paid only if a complete final application and documentation are submitted by Oct. 30, 2019. This offer is available to all DTE electric business customers and contractors.

Large project bonus

With the 2019 Electric trade ally bonus program, the DTE Energy Efficiency Program for Business seeks to reward Designated Trade Allies for their dedicated work on large projects.

Between Jan. 1, 2019 and Nov. 30, 2019, eligible designated trade allies can receive a 10% bonus on electric measures for submitting complete final applications for projects that result in a paid incentive of at least \$9,100 in a single category. Electric trade ally bonuses are calculated according to paid incentives per measure category.

Bonus dollars will be paid per application, with a check payable to each designated trade ally. Any final application submitted by a designated trade ally prior to Jan. 1, 2019 or after Nov. 30, 2019 will not qualify for a reward. Any projects previously applied for and cancelled will not qualify for a reward.

Eligible participants in the 2019 electric trade ally bonus program must:

- Be a designated trade ally in good standing on the date of enrollment and remain in good standing throughout the 2019 program year
- Submit a completed, signed electric trade ally bonus program application to: saveenergy@dteenergy.com
- Reservation and final applications submitted prior to completing the program enrollment application will not be eligible for the electric trade ally bonus
- Trade allies who are not able to receive third party incentive checks are not eligible to participate in the electric trade ally bonus program
